Sessions

The workshop was inaugurated by Dr. Arupjyoti Choudhury, Registrar (i/c), KKHSOU in presence of Prof. N.N. Sarma, Director, CIQA, KKHSOU; Prof. Uma Kanjilal, Director (i/c), Inter University Consortium for Technology Enabled Flexible Education and Development (IUC-TEFED), IGNOU; Dr. Nisha Singh, Deputy Director, (IUC-TEFED); Dr. K.Gowthaman, Deputy Director, (IUC-TEFED) and faculty members and other officers of KKHSOU. The main objective of the workshop was to develop an action plan for adoption and development of MOOC courses in SWAYAM platform of MHRD.

In her session, Prof. Uma Kanjilal highlighted various aspects of massive open online courses (MOOCs) in the Indian context. As IGNOU is one of the National Coordinators of SWAYAM, she also elaborated on development and adoption of SWAYAM courses in diploma and certificate level.

Dr. Nisha Singh, another resource person demonstrated how proposals can be submitted to IGNOU for development of SWAYAM courses. She also highlighted on different aspects of SWAYAM-PRABHA, the 32 DTH educational TV channels, a MHRD Project, Govt of India.

Dr. K. Gowthaman presented a brief description on equipment setup & specifications for use in the development of SWAYAM Courses. He also demonstrated different technological aspects on developing MOOC courses on SWAYAM platform.

In the last technical session, participants were engaged in preparation of model MOOC course proposals for submission to SWAYAM. The two days programme ended with distribution of

certificates to the participants and vote of thanks by Dr. Prasenjit Das, Department of English, KKHSOU.
